This Prospectus relates to admission to VIII Semester B.Sc. Nursing Degree Course for the Academic year 2026-2027 in Archana college of nursing, Pandalam

This prospectus contains rules and regulations for the admission and selection for all seats of BSc Nursing Degree Course for the Academic Year 2026-2027.

The Conditions in this Prospectus is subject to modification/addition/deletion, as may be deemed necessary by the Management and will be subject to further orders, if any, passed by appropriate authorities / Courts of law.

Applicants must go through the Prospectus carefully and familiarize themselves with all relevant information. They are also encouraged to visit the College's official Website, i.e.,

## HOW TO APPLY

- Application for admission to course B.Sc. Nursing course can be registered only online through a single application. The provision for applying online is available at the website [www.pncmak.in](http://www.pncmak.in). Submission of more than one application by a candidate will lead to rejection of the candidate.
- Application procedure will be as per the direction from the Admission Supervisory Committee for Medical Educations in Kerala and as per the provisions of the Prospectus issued by competent authorities in this regard.
- Documents to be submitted along with the Application are:
- Self attested copies of Mark lists of all parts of Higher Secondary or equivalent Examination and pass certificate in the qualifying examination.
- Self attested copy of the relevant page of S.S.L.C or Equivalent certificate to prove the date of birth.
- Self attested copy of Aadhaar
- Equivalency certificate from Higher Secondary Board, Kerala, for candidates who have completed qualifying examination from outside Kerala state.
- For foreign nationals, the entry qualification equivalency i.e., 12th standard can be obtained from Association of Indian Universities, New Delhi.
- Copy of recent Conduct Certificates (not prior to six months) from the Head of the Institution in which the candidate studied last.
- Caste and income certificate from Village officer/ Tahsildar if the candidate is to be considered under any reservation seat (SC/ST, OBC). There is no need for income certificate for SC/ST candidates.

## **ADMISSION & PAYMENT OF FEES**

The students shall pay all fees of the 1<sup>st</sup> semester of the course at the time of admission which will not be refunded under any circumstances.

### **Fee as per the decision of the fee regulatory committee/ Govt.of Kerala**

All other fees are due to statutory bodies (KUHS, KNMC & INC) as and when notified later by the Government. Levy of fee on provisional basis is subject to modification depending on the fee regulated by the FRC. This fact shall be specially stated in the prospectus. The College will not retain the first year Tuition and other fees, if the students discontinue the course before the last date of admission stipulated by the competent authorities and also issue the TC and certificates without any delay. But the candidate discontinues the course, after the closing of admission as notified by the authority, the candidate must pay the full fee of their course (VIII Semesters). The Transfer Certificate will be issued only after payment of the above amount. Also, Legal proceedings will be initiated against the student/parent for the realization of the full amount of fees.

### **NRI SEATS**

The Management is entitled to fill up to 15% of the total seats in the NRI category by admitting qualified students who are dependents of NRIs. According to GO(MS)No.243/2014/H&F WD dated 06.08.2014, "An Applicant who depends upon his/her Father / Mother / Brothers and Sisters (inclusive of first cousins) / Husband / Wife / Brothers and Sisters (inclusive of first cousins) of Father or Mother / Half Brother / Half Sister / Adopted Father or Adopted Mother who is working abroad" will only be eligible to apply in the NRI category seats. As per the Fee Structure prescribed for the NRI category seats by AFRC Order no. FRC50/22/B.Sc. P.B.S. /M.Sc. (N)/ dated 20.06.2022, the Annual Tuition Fee payable by students being admitted under the NRI category seats is **Rs. /-** per year. All other fees including special fees are applicable to students admitted under the NRI.

## **ALLOCATION OF SEATS**

- Medical Fitness Certificate from a registered medical practitioner having MBBS or higher qualification
- Eight passport size & one stamp size photo (Name & date of Birth in one passport size photo with white background)
- Undertaking regarding non-involvement in ragging
- Undertaking of Dowry prohibition act
- Two sets of photocopies of documents from 1 to 8 in the list

## **NRI STUDENTS**

- Relationship certificate of the Sponsor and student to be issued by the Revenue Authorities (Relationship should be established). If the sponsor is the Father / Mother of the applicant, educational certificates of the applicant containing the name of the sponsors shall be accepted
- Overseas Employment Certificate issued by the Employer, attested by the Embassy and if self-employed, it should also be attested by the Embassy. In case of non-submission of the Embassy Certificate, the endorsement in the passport of the sponsor about the employment by the Embassy/Consulates shall be accepted. Certificate issued by the Embassy/Consulate stating that the sponsor is a Non-Resident Indian (NRI) or an Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) or the green card documents shall be accepted in lieu of the Overseas Employment Certificate issued by the Employer and attested by the Embassy.
- Passport with Visa stamped on it and attested by the Embassy.
- A self-affidavit of the relationship between the sponsor and the candidate (Sponsor certificate).
- The sponsor should be an Indian Citizen/Overseas citizen of India/Person of Indian Origin and have relevant documents to prove the same.
- Documents related to NRI admission should be uploaded while submitting the application, failing which may lead to rejection of the application

## **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

### **Criteria of eligibility for admission and selection Schedule**

#### **Academic:**

Candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary Examination of the Board of Higher Secondary Education of Kerala or equivalent examinations recognized by any of the Universities in the State of Kerala with an Aggregate of 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, Biology and 50% marks in English only are eligible for admission. A Rank List will be prepared based on total marks secured for PLUS TWO examinations (PLUS ONE mark will be excluded). Those who completed PLUS TWO outside Kerala/India should submit an equivalency certificate from the Board of Higher Secondary Education of Kerala along with their migration certificate.

**Age:**

Applicants should have completed 17 years of age on 31st December 2026. No relaxation of the minimum age will be allowed.

Self-attested copy of the relevant page of school record namely SSLC/ICSE/CBSE/Certificate showing the date of birth/copy of the birth certificate should be produced at the time of admission.

## **SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS**

### **UNIFORM**

Students are required to wear the full uniform instructed by the College in clinical and in class room and must follow strict disciplinary rules accordingly.

During clinical posting students should have their hair put up and should wear prescribed footwear.

### **STUDENTS ACTIVITIES**

- Students are expected to participate in all the activities organized by the college.
- To use leisure time creatively and effectively, they are provided with facilities for indoor and outdoor games.

### **CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE**

- Students are expected to behave politely and give due respect to all staff at Archana College of Nursing. They should behave in a manner that upholds the values of our nation and the institution.
- All students should report in their respective classes before prayer time.
- No student will be allowed to enter the college if not in complete uniform.
- A fine shall be imposed on loss of identity card.
- During working hours students are expected to be in their respective classrooms. Strolling around in the campus or outside is strictly prohibited during working hours.
- Parents are hereby requested not to provide students with motor vehicles for conveyance to and from college.
- Students are to follow working schedule strictly. Late comers will not be allowed to attend classes.
- Students are expected to attend all classes without fail. If for unavoidable reasons, leave of absence is required, permission should be obtained from the Principal in written. Unauthorized absenteeism will be viewed seriously. Students who absent themselves without prior permission from Principal shall be fined and will be allowed to enter classes only after his/her parent comes and meets the Principal in person.
- Students are eligible for duty leave if they perform a certain kind of duty for the college as decided by the Principal.
- Students who do not satisfy the attendance requirements and internal assessment marks as stipulated by the University will have to face the consequences as per the University regulations.
- Smoking, alcohol and other substance abuse are strictly prohibited in the campus. Students found guilty will face serious disciplinary action

- Day scholars should not stay back for longer than half an hour in the campus after working hours. Those found loitering in or around campus longer than that will have to face disciplinary action.
- Students should view it as their responsibility to switch off the fans and lights if not in use in their class rooms.
- Students entering library should abide by the rules of library strictly. Any violations can lead to a fine.
- Students should take care not to damage college property. Causing damage to any of the college property can lead to a fine on all those students who use the same.
- Hostel students are to strictly abide by the hostel rules, any violation of which can lead to fine or expulsion.
- Students are responsible for their personal belongings. College will not bear the loss or damage to any of the same.
- Students who bring food from home are to use a re-usable tiffin box. Disposable food packets are not allowed in view of serious environmental pollution caused by them.
- Students are not allowed to remain in the dining hall or canteen for more than the stipulated time.
- Shouting or making excessive noise in the campus will not be tolerated. Students should behave themselves in a manner befitting to the professional course they are pursuing.
- Students shall not get involved in any nefarious activities. Ragging is strictly prohibited by State Legislation and by Supreme Court order. It is a non bailable offence and those who indulge in such antisocial activities will be immediately handed over to the police.
- Students should not indulge in any political activity in the campus.
- Students should refrain from organizing or attending meetings on their own without permission from the Principal. Collecting money or distributing bills or notices without permission from the Principal is strictly prohibited.
- Students should help to keep the campus and classrooms neat and tidy. A fine shall be imposed if any student is caught littering.
- Students should submit their assignments, homework and records in time.
- Students should volunteer to take up extracurricular activities and participate in lectures, seminars, debates etc.
- Students should maintain decorum and discipline during assemblies/meetings/cultural programmes etc
- Violation of any of the above can lead to disciplinary action from the college management in the form of fine, suspension or expulsion.

## **RAGGING**

Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited in the College. Any student who indulges in any form of ragging will be subjected to penal action as per the provisions of the law. Also, the student will be expelled from the College as detailed in the law concerned and as per the Honourable Supreme Court of India's directions in this regard.

## **USE OF MOBILE PHONE**

Use of Mobile Phones by students is not allowed on the campus. Any violation of this prohibition will lead to stringent disciplinary action by the College authorities.

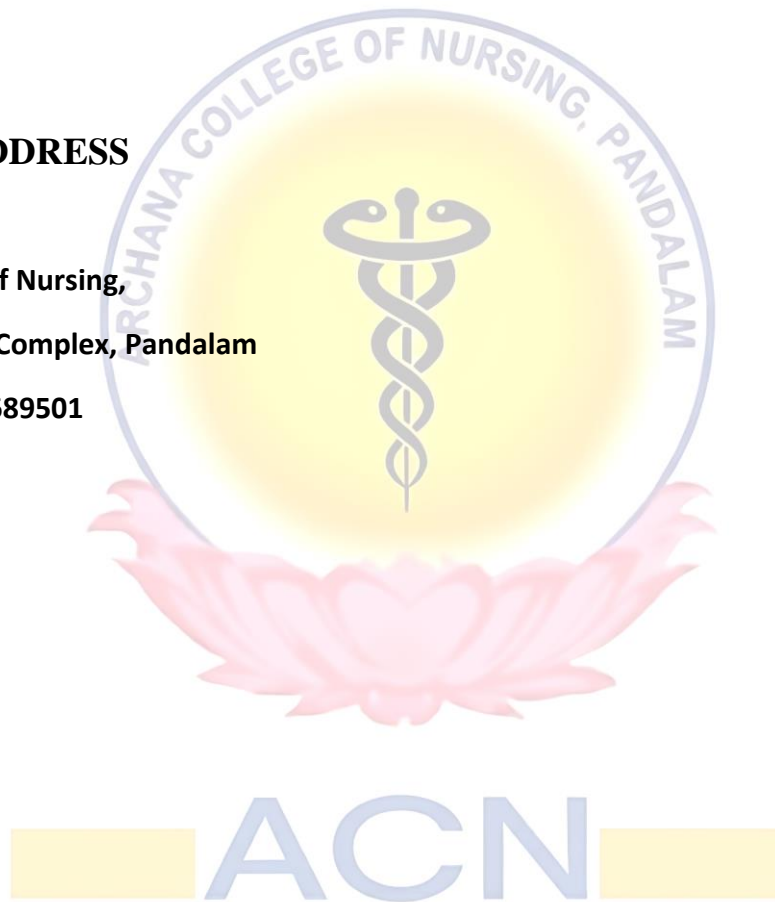

The duration of the course is 8 Semesters. The rules regarding the method of selection for the B.Sc. Nursing Degree Courses and other rules regarding the admission process are provisional and subject to the guidelines, orders and instructions issued by the Government, Indian Nursing Council, Kerala Nurses and Midwives Council, Kerala University of Health Sciences and Admission Supervisory Committee. All the applicants seeking admission to the B.Sc. Nursing Degree Courses for the academic year 2026-27 are bound by the final decisions of the above-mentioned statutory bodies and Courts of Law.

### Core Competencies for Nursing and Midwifery Practice by B.Sc. Nursing Graduate
